

## QUESTIONS FOR DISCUSSION AND REFLECTION

### BEFORE VIEWING

(Review) What were some key ideas from the last session. Discuss.

1. Talk about someone that you have observed and that God has used to bear fruit through. What have you noticed about them and the way God has used them to bear fruit?
2. Have you ever felt that the church can be a competitive place? What made you feel that way?

### AFTER VIEWING

1. Talk about the significance that we sometimes pursue in this earth (applause, money, position, power, reputation, etc.) and contrast it against what the scriptures reveal about significance.
2. In 2 Corinthians Paul warns of the dangers of comparing ourselves to others. Why is it unwise and even dangerous to do this? In which area of your life are you guilty of comparing yourself to others?
3. If you're currently adopting your perception of your significance (even some of it) from your job title, or your car, (or your possessions, or your looks, or your education) how is that affecting your every day walk with the Lord? How might you change that paradigm to reflect your real significance? What practical steps can you take?
4. Think of a time that you got caught up in what others thought of you. Talk about the dangers of this trap.
5. Jesus lived and led FROM significance and NOT FOR significance. How would that shift in your own thinking, living and leading FROM significance, impact your life?

### FOLLOW UP

1. In 13:3-5 – "Jesus knew that the father had put all things under his power, and that he had come from God and was returning to God; so he got up from the meal, took off his outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around his waist. After that, he poured water into a basin and began to wash his disciples' feet..."
2. Journal about these prompts
  - a. What might that look like in your life?
  - b. What might prevent you from following Christ's example?
  - c. How might living FROM significance change your life and ministry?
